NOTICE-PLEASE READ!

The Polk County Gun Club Pistol Range will close on Monday, May 12, 2008. At that time construction on new berms, a drainage system, signage, and surfacing will begin. This work will also involve moving the road between the shotgun fields and the rifle range.

There will be **NO** shooting on or around the pistol range **whatsoever** while the construction is going on. This rule is to be observed regardless of whether the construction workers are present or not. The board will do everything that can be done safely to keep the other ranges open during this process, but be advised that at times some scheduled pistol activities may have to be moved to the rifle range berm. The board will examine this on a case by case basis.

Upon completion of the Pistol Range reconstruction, members desiring to shoot on the range will be required to complete a short Pistol Range Certification course. Upon completion of the training, a pistol range endorsement will be added to your membership card and records. At that point you may resume shooting on the pistol range. Anyone shooting on the pistol range without such endorsement will be removed from the club.

The reconstruction of the pistol range is involving many hours of effort by the board and a large expenditure of funds. It is the board's and the membership's responsibility to take care of the new facility and assets. A continuous history of poor gun handling, disregard of rules, and outright vandalism make it necessary to implement this training program. The old attitude of "if you don't want it shot, don't leave it on the range" ceases now.

The board appreciates the cooperation of the members while these changes are in process. The new pistol range assets, **ATTITUDES**, and training will go a long way in making POLK COUNTY GUN CLUB the most fun, safest, and most attractive facility anywhere.
